**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 671,
CHAPTER 179, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Honesdale (hereinafter Borough) enacted the an amendment to Chapter 179, Streets and Sidewalks, Article I, Section 179-16 on or about April 22, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Borough that a portion of the foregoing legislation may compromise some road opening and or road repair projects and may cause hardship to Borough residents and property owners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and the same is enacted and ordained, by the Borough Council of Honesdale Borough, Wayne County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Chapter 179, Article I, Section 179-16, Permit Required, Subparagraph E, Ordinance No. 671) is hereby amended as follows:

1. Existing Section 179-16, Subparagraph E shall henceforth be as follows:

From November 15 through March 15, there shall be no street openings or excavations whatsoever, except in emergency conditions, and then only under the strict supervisors of the Honesdale Borough Director of public Works.

2. Any Ordinances, or part(s) thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and/or amended as the case may be.

3. This Ordinance, and subject amendment provided for herein, shall become effective five (5) days after the adoption thereof.
