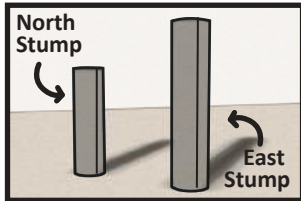


Design Those Stumps!

Recently, two dying trees in Honesdale’s Central Park were partially cut down. Keeping the standing trunks/stumps is good for the soil. It also creates an opportunity for everyone who loves Central Park to be involved in a new project. A chainsaw artist will be cutting designs into the stumps, and YOU can draw and share what you imagine they should look like! A panel of artists will review submissions and the public will vote on the 3 finalists for each stump. The Borough will review the winning designs and they’ll be cut into the stumps.

Instructions:

1. Visit Central Park to think about what ideas might be fun and interesting on the stumps.
2. Draw your ideas on these North Stump and East Stump rectangles. Note: Each rectangle will be rolled to make a 3D (cylindrical) stump, so your designs should fill the rectangles.
3. Cut out the rectangles. Write your contact info on the bottom reverse side for each.
4. Make two cylinders by connecting each rectangle’s long sides together with glue or tape.
5. Share your designs* by April 14! Assembled designs can be dropped off at the WCAA at 959 Main Street. Flat designs can be emailed to waynecountyartsalliance@gmail.com.
